Course Offerings

Adult High School

Prepares students for academic and personal success by providing students who have withdrawn from high school an alternate path to earning high school credits and ultimately, a district-issued high school diploma.

The program provides supportive services for students in the areas of guidance and counseling, testing, computer instruction, and specialized reading, writing, and mathematics courses. Students enrolled to earn a high school diploma must be tested to determine program placement prior to registration.

Adult Basic Education

Prepares students to enroll in GED preparation courses. Instruction is received in one or more content areas of reading, math, or language. Students are tested to determine what specific areas they need to work on in order to succeed in the GED preparation program.

GED Preparation

Prepares students to successfully take the GED exam. Instruction is received in all four areas of the test and focuses on the specific skills and knowledge required to earn a State of Florida GED diploma.
