We are so excited to kick off the Sunshine Challenge for 2020-2021 school year. The Sunshine State Young Readers Award Program is a statewide reading motivational program for students grade 3-8, sponsored by the Florida Department of Education and Florida Association for Media in Education. The purpose of the program is to encourage students to read independently for pleasure and to read books that are on, above, and below their reading level to improve their reading fluency.



Students that read *at least 10* S.S.Y.R.A. books & pass the A.R. quiz will be invited to attend the Sunshine Party at the end of the school year. Students also receive a "Sunshine Tag" for each S.S.Y.R.A. Book they read & *pass* the A.R. quiz. Tags will be distributed during visits to the E.L.H. Media Center.
