END OF COURSE EXAMS

The School District of Nassau County is offering an opportunity for private school students to participate in the Spring Administration of Statewide End-of-Course (EOC) exams.

The EOC assessments offered this Spring are listed below.

Algebra 1 EOC
 Civics
 US History

• Geometry EOC • Biology

To participate in the Spring Administration, parents and students must:

- 1. Read and complete the required activities on the *Florida End-of-Course Assessments Private School Student Parent/Guardian Information Sheet*.
 - Students are required to practice using an online test prior to the test. All students must take an electronic practice test (ePAT) prior to arriving to the test site for each EOC test.
 - FSA EOCS (Algebra 1, Geometry)
 The FSA EOC Training Tests (http://www.fsassessments.org/training-tests) can be accessed and taken using any computer for the student to practice.
 - NGSSS EOCS (Biology, Civics, US History)
 EOC ePats (http://www.flassessments.com/ePATs) can be accessed and taken using any computer for the student to practice.
 - o If the student has not practiced prior to taking the EOC test, they will be excused from the test site, and will have to retake the test at the next available test window.
- 2. Complete the Private School Student Registration Form for End-of-Course Testing.
- 3. Complete the 2018-2019 Private School Student Accommodations Request Form (for students with an IEP or 504 plan).
- 4. Provide a stamped, self-addressed envelope in order to receive student's test score.
- 5. Submit all documents by **Friday March 29, 2019** to:

Please review the following information and requirements regarding your private school student's participation in the upcoming Florida End-of-Course (EOC) Assessment administration.

Student Registration Form and Registration

Registration is required and must be completed as follows:

Student Identification on Day of Test Requirement

The Florida Department of Education has created the following rule for admission of students to testing rooms: "Precautions must be taken at testing sites when students are unknown to the test administrator or other school staff. For security purposes, photo identification, such as a Florida ID or school ID, must be checked before admitting unfamiliar students to a testing room."

Your student MUST present **photo identification** to staff to verify his/her identity. **Please ensure that your student has a school or Florida-issued Photo ID on the date of testing.** Florida ID cards can be purchased at a local branch of the Department of Motor Vehicles. More information is at http://www.dmv.org/fl-florida/id-cards.php. A current passport is also acceptable if the picture is recent enough for recognition.

Practice Test Requirement

All students who will participate in an EOC assessment must participate in a Student Practice Test for that subject prior to test day. You are responsible for ensuring that your student has taken the practice test at home or at his or her private school using the appropriate administration script that guides students through the online platform. The purpose of the practice test is to orient students to the types of items and response formats on computer-based tests. Student responses should not be used as an indicator of student performance on the actual test.

• FSA EOCS (Algebra 1, Geometry)

The FSA EOC Training Tests (http://www.fsassessments.org/training-tests) can be accessed and taken using any computer for the student to practice. If the student has not practiced prior to taking the EOC test, they will be excused from the test site, and will have to retake the test at the next available test window.

NGSSS EOCS (Biology, Civics, US History)
 EOC ePats (http://www.flassessments.com/ePATs) can be accessed and taken using any computer for the student to practice.

Prior to testing, test administrators will ask students if they have participated in a Practice Test; If the student has not practiced prior to taking the EOC test, they will be excused from the test site, and will have to retake the test at the next available test window.

Testing Policies

Please be sure to review the following policies and discuss them with your student before testing:

- Electronic Devices—If your student is found with ANY electronic devices, including, but not limited
 to, cell phones, smart phones, or smart watches during testing, including breaks (e.g. bathroom,
 lunch), his or her test will be invalidated, which means it will not be scored. The best practice is for
 students to leave devices at home on the day of testing.
- Testing Rules Acknowledgment—All EOC assessments include a Testing Rules Acknowledgment that reads, "I understand the testing rules that were just read to me. If I do not follow these rules, my test score may be invalidated." Prior to testing, test administrators will read the rules to students, and students must acknowledge that they understand the testing rules by electronically checking a box next to the statement or by signature.
- Discussing Test Content after Testing—The last portion of the testing rules read to students before they sign/check the acknowledgement reads, "Because the content in all statewide assessments is secure, you may not discuss or reveal details about the test items after the test. This includes any type of electronic communication, such as texting, emailing, or posting online, for example, on websites like Facebook, Twitter, or Instagram." Please make sure that your student understands that he or she may not discuss test items, even without the intent to cheat. This includes any kind of electronic communications, such as texting, emailing, or posting to blogs or social media websites (Facebook, Twitter, etc.).
- Test Invalidations—Students are responsible for doing their own work on the test and for protecting their answers from being seen by others. If students are caught cheating during testing, their tests will be invalidated. In addition, the FLDOE employs a test security company, Caveon Test Security, to analyze student test results to detect unusual similarities in answer patterns.
 - Student results within a classroom that are found to have extremely similar answer patterns will be invalidated.
- **Leaving Campus**—If your student leaves the testing facility before completing the test (for lunch, an appointment, or illness, etc.), he or she WILL NOT be allowed to complete the test.

Test Administration Details

- All EOC Assessments are delivered via a computer-based test (CBT) platform.
 - Algebra 1 and Geometry EOCs are administered on the FSA Test Delivery System (TDS)
 - o Civics, Biology and US History are administered on the TestNav platform
- The following chart contains the EOC assessment times:

Algebra 1 EOC	Two 90-minute sessions,	May 7 th – May 16 th
Geometry EOC	1 session per day for 2 days	Day and Starting Time are specific to each school
Civics, Biology,	One 160 -minute session,	May 7 th – May 14 th
US History	one day	Day and Starting Time are specific to each school

Your Student's Score

Student scores are reported on a score scale that varies by subject test, but all EOC scores are reported in five Achievement Levels. Students must achieve at least the minimum scale score in Achievement Level 3 to pass the assessment.

Receiving Scores: Parents/guardians of private school students must provide a stamped, self-addressed envelope at the time of Registration, and will be mailed an individual, hard-copy report when the reports are provided by the Florida Department of Education.
