## Need insurance or had Medicaid in another state?

Immediately begin working to obtain FL Medicaid. Supposedly, it is best to apply at the 1st of the month, but don't wait. Cancel your former state's Medicaid, and ask for a "closure letter". Also, keep the name and number of your former Case Worker. When you apply in Florida, make sure the income you report is within 10% of what they confirm. A phone interview is required, so make sure they have a good phone number to reach you during the day. If you are an Unaccompanied Homeless Youth, ask for permission to keep your phone with you in school for this purpose. Students do not have to reside with a parent or guardian to qualify. Mark "unaccompanied homeless youth" on the application.
