Unaccompanied Homeless Youth (UHY)?

(UHY=not living with a parent or legal guardian)

UHY who are at least 16 years old may request an "Unaccompanied Homeless Youth Certificate for the Purposes of Accessing Health Services" form from Angie McClellan at 277-9021. This form allows unaccompanied, homeless minors to sign for their own health care.

There is also a form and funds for obtaining a **Birth Certificate**.
