

GENERAL KNOWLEDGE TEST RESOURCES



Mastery of General Knowledge may be demonstrated by one of the following (per FS 1012.56):

- Passing scores on the Florida General Knowledge Test earned no more than 10 years prior to the date of application.
- A valid standard certificate from another U.S. state or territory.
- A certificate issued by the National Board for Professional Teaching Standards (NBPTS)
- Two semesters of full-time or equivalent part-time college teaching experience earned at an accredited or approved institution.
- Passing scores on approved national or international exams that tests comparable content to include the revised Graduate Record Examination (GRE) (2011) earned on or after July 1, 2015.

The most common path to satisfying this requirement is passing the Florida General Knowledge Test, which is divided into four sections: (1) Mathematics, (2) Reading, (3) English Language Skills, and (4) Essay. All four sections must be passed to satisfy GK, but they do not have to be passed during the same test session.
