## INTENDED USE

- Renewal of your Florida Educator Certificate.
- Addition of an endorsement to your Florida Educator Certificate.
- Addition of a content area to your Florida Educator Certificate, except for the areas listed under exclusions.

This form must be completed and submitted to the Human Resources Department to authorize a one (1) time payroll deduction to satisfy the fee as outlined below in the Fee Schedule. This form must accompany the completed Educator Certification Notice Form for Additions or the Educator Certification Notice Form for Renewals.

## **EXCLUSIONS**

- Upgrade applications (temporary to professional) must be processed by the Florida Department of Education, including the payment of any applicable fees.
- Addition applications for the following content areas must be processed by the Florida Department of Education, including the payment of any applicable fees: Educational Leadership, School Counselor, Reading (K-12)\*, School Psychologist, School Social Worker or Speech Language Impaired.
  - \*Reading (K-12) is not the same as the Reading Endorsement, which should be processed through the Human Resources Department.
- Athletic Coaching Certificates must be processed by the Florida Department of Education, including the payment of any applicable fees.
