

ParaPro Assessment

Florida State College at Jacksonville offers the ParaPro Assessment to certify teachers' aides and assistants to instruct school children. The exam is given **by appointment only** through the Certification and Assessment Center at the Downtown Campus.

The ParaPro Assessment is for both prospective and practicing paraprofessionals. It measures skills and knowledge in reading, math and writing, and the ability to apply those skills and knowledge to classroom instruction. This computer-based test consists of 90 multi-choice questions and lasts about $2\frac{1}{2}$ hours. The exam fee is \$55, payable before testing, and is nonrefundable. Please be prepared to pay the \$55 with a debit/credit card or electronic checking draft upon arriving at the Assessment Center. Cash cannot be accepted. ETS policy requires a 21 day waiting period before a repeat test can be issued. Official scores are provided two-three weeks later to the county you name.
