NOTICE OF ELECTRICAL APPRENTICESHIP OPPORTUNITY

The Jacksonville Electrical Joint Apprenticeship Training Committee, now doing business as the Electrical Training Alliance of Jacksonville, is accepting applications for the apprenticeship daily Monday through Friday. Applicants can apply in person at 4951 Richard Street, Jacksonville, Florida between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Applicants may also apply at **etajax.org**. Applicants **must meet the following minimum qualifications** to qualify for an interview:

- 1. **AGE** must be at least 18 years of age. **Birth Certificate Required**
- 2. **EDUCATION** High School Graduate or G.E.D., with at least 1 high school credit of Algebra 1. Official high school transcript **AND** G.E.D. scores are required.
- 3. **PHYSICAL CONDITION** must be physically able to perform the work.
- 4. DRIVER LICENSE must possess and maintain a valid driver's license or State Issued I.D.
- 5. **QUALIFYING SCORE** must obtain a qualifying score on the Electrical Trades Aptitude Test.

Veterans must furnish a copy of their DD214 or DD2648 with re-enlistment code at the bottom.

Applicants must meet all (1-4) of the above OR have 2,000 verifiable hours of electrical construction experience.

The Apprenticeship Committee will interview each applicant who meets all of the minimum qualifications. The interviewers will consider each applicants reliability, interest, attitude, judgment, cooperation, as well as other personal traits. Applicants must meet all of the minimum requirements by the posted deadline to be eligible for an interview. Applicant selection is based according to interview ranking score. Hybrid Program positions may be offered to qualifying applicants. Applicants are encouraged to work as **Construction Wireman** prior to apprenticeship interview. **Construction Wireman** starting wage is \$11.00/hour plus N.E.B.F. retirement. A valid driver's license, social security card or birth certificate, and employer drug testing are required for employment.
