UPDATES

Ms. Drake reported:

- ❖ Teacher evaluations are underway.
- ❖ YHS is in Testing Mode. The SAT Test Day was run as trial and it ran smoothly. FSA ELA Reading and Math will each be consolidated into two (2) days to give students the maximum opportunity to have class time on test days.
- ❖ Nassauville Rezoning paperwork was all run through the schools; of 120 students affected by the change, all but 12 will be staying.
- ❖ YHS had one (1) teaching unit cut for next year. She will be speaking directly with Superintendent Burns about her concerns in regards to enrollment numbers.
- ❖ YHS will be hosting a regional AVID Path Training at our school on May 24-25. Up to seven (7) of our teachers will be able to attend for free.
- ❖ Baker County HS will be coming to YHS to observe our Tardy policy / PBIS in action.
- ❖ One of YHS guidance counselors will be moving to Wildlight Elementary; Ms. Malin has been hired and is on board learning the system now.
- ❖ YHS PTO is hosting a College Fair on April 29th from 10:00 AM until 1:00 PM in YHS cafeteria. This is open to all Nassau County high school students.

- ❖ YHS juniors will have an assembly on May 19 about FAFSA. There will be an ROTC scholarship recipient speaking about how to write a college essay.
- ❖ YHS is proactively signing up 10th grade intensive reading students for the SAT, in case they didn't pass the FSA.
- ❖ YHS will have the senior awards assembly on May 16th at 9:30 AM in the cafeteria to recognize scholarships and academic awards.
- ❖ Invitations have been ordered for the Baccalaureate service on May 15th, to try to make sure parents are aware of the details.
