UPDATES

Ms. Drake reported:

- State SAC funds were released for School Year 2016-17. Projected School Improvement funds for 2017-18 were included on the information sheet Ms. Drake handed out (Attachment #2).
- The 2015-16 School Financial Report will be up on website as part of our full disclosure guidelines (Attachment #3). Special note was made of how little of our funding comes from the Florida Lottery (less than one half of one half of one percent).
- We are in full End of Year mode. Formal EOCs finished today (Thursday 5/18); Graduation tomorrow (Friday 5/19), TEOCs Monday and Tuesday of next week.
- ❖ The Florida legislature passed a budget that reduces public school funding by 10%. Governor Scott still has the opportunity to Veto.
- YHS will most likely start the school year with a part-time teacher, with the thought that a unit will be added and that teacher will become full-time.

S.I.P. Funds Request (Ms. Scarberry)

Ms. Scarberry made a formal request (Attachments #4-6) for \$1794.00 to purchase a 1 year, 3 course membership for two (2) teacher licenses for www.mathteachercoach.com. After Ms. Scarberry explained her request and answered questions, Ms. Miller made a motion that the SAC committee awards \$1794.00 to Ms. Scarberry for her request; Mr. Causey seconded. The motion passed.
